

CLP LABEL COMPLIANCE REVIEW

Before & After — Consumer Product Label Remediation

A CLP label audit of a hazardous mixture intended for the EU market. The original label carried several non-conformities that would fail enforcement. This review documents each finding against Regulation (EC) No 1272/2008, then delivers a corrected, market-ready label.

SCENARIO A brand owner submits an existing product label for pre-launch review. The mixture is classified Flam. Liq. 3 and Eye Irrit. 2, but the label omits mandatory elements.	DELIVERABLE A findings log mapped to CLP articles, plus a corrected label artwork specification ready for print.
FRAMEWORKS APPLIED CLP (EC) 1272/2008 Title III · Annex I · label element & pictogram dimension rules	OUTCOME 7 non-conformities identified and resolved; label brought to enforcement-ready compliance.

1	Missing product identifier detail & nominal quantity	Art. 18	Added full identifier and nominal quantity statement.
2	Only one pictogram — eye irritation pictogram omitted	Art. 19 · Annex V	Added GHS07 for Eye Irrit. 2.
3	Hazard/precautionary statements written as free text, not H/P codes	Art. 21–22	Replaced with verbatim H226, H319 and required P-statements.
4	No supplier identity (name, address, phone)	Art. 17(1) (a)	Added full supplier block.
5	No UFI present for a hazardous mixture	Annex VIII	Added UFI placeholder; PCN submission flagged.
6	Signal word "Warning" used but not visually distinct	Art. 20	Bolded and colour-set the signal word.
7	No identity of hazardous components on label	Art. 18(3) (b)	Added "Contains..." statement for the contributing substance.
